Covid-19:

Well #2 Emergency Motor Replacement:

The insurance claim money for the motor replacement has been approved by the Insurance Company and we have received payment for it. M. Aiken found an additional bill and will be submitting it to the Insurance Company.

Special District Meeting:

M. Aiken will be informing the Clerk/Treasurer, B. Miller that we will be removing our article from the warrant (Well #2 Emergency pump replacement). M. Aiken or F. DeToma will explain to the constituents at the meeting why it is being removed (Our insurance has covered the expense).

North Pole Estates:

Chicopee Concrete has yet to supply information or taken care of the decommissioning of the monitoring wells which they have destroyed due to quarry operations on the property.

D. Luis believes they are in violation and should have their permit revoked.

M. Aiken has been trying to get an answer from the DEP for several months. He sent another e-mail to Catherine Sarafinas-Hamilton (DEP rep.) this week in regards to the sand and gravel operation in the zone 2, asking who has jurisdiction over this. The reply back from C. Sarafinas-Hamilton was; I will try to find out and let you know.

Parking Lot:

The new pavement is down, the area has been re-seeded. New trees will be planted in the future.

Other Business:

- There was a leak at Skinner Hall. MHC will be replacing the old line sometime in the future.
